Heart Stone Farm (div of FWBFM) is an active farm that serves as home to horses and registered angus cattle. The farm is situated on approximately 200 acres nestled in the Cherokee National Forest, bordering the Unaka Mountain range.

There are sound structures on the farm including two barns with stalls, tack area, shelters, and farm offices. The Heart Stone Farm is solely owned and operated by Free Will Baptist Family Ministries.

What is missing from this farm is the proper facilities to teach and train youth and students in a proper classroom environment. A newly proposed **Agricultural Therapy & Training Educational Facility (ATTEF)** will provide essential resources for the students by providing state of the art technology to better enhance the teaching and training methods of existing equine, bovine and agriculture curriculum. The new center will focus on extending classroom learning to a more hands-on approach, improving delivery/teaching methods of essential subjects such as math, health and science.

A new center will provide laboratory classrooms to educate students and members of the community about proper equine care, livestock, farm machinery and equipment, veterinary management practices, barn management, artificial insemination of animals, general farm animal health, agriculture sales and marketing, including leadership and communication skills, that are often overlooked in most programs.



The **Agricultural Therapy & Training Educational Facility** will be located on the property owned by Free Will Baptist Family Ministries adjacent to the existing Heart Stone Farm.

The facility will house auditorium style classrooms, complete with laboratory and conference areas. The focal point of the facility will be the indoor, year-round show/riding arena in the center of the facility, surrounded by stalls, feed and tack rooms, hay storage, breeding stalls, wash areas, horse and cattle tie out areas, restrooms and administrative offices.
