The Hope Center, our crisis pregnancy/resource center, currently has a client base between 350 to 375, serving families through our office visits, over the phone or through our 24-hour Hopeline **1-866-319-HOPE(4673)**. In 2007, 15 babies have been born to our clients & we have given out over 300 packs of diapers.

Included in every visit and phone call is a message of hope and healing found in a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. We strive to demonstrate and share that truth with each person who walks through the door or calls on the phone. The Hope Line calls include:

- ♥ An hour-long conversation at 1 a.m. with a student terrified a possible pregnancy might end her college career
- ♥ A 42-year-old divorcee on the other end asking "Where is the nearest abortion clinic?"
- ♥ A desperate mom needing formula & diapers for her newborn
- ♥ A 15-year-old afraid to tell her parents she's pregnant

In 1938, at a meeting of the TN State Association of FWB, a motion and unanimous approval was made to purchase property and begin an orphanage. A 160-acre site in Greene County, Tennessee, was purchased for \$4,500.

In 1939, the Tennessee FWB Orphanage, opened under the care of Mr. & Mrs. I L Stanley.

With a name change in 1998 to Free Will Baptist Family Ministries to accommodate the variety of services now provided, the orphanage that began almost 70 years ago has now expanded into a multi-faceted & diverse ministry.

Trula Cronk Homes for Children

The Trula Cronk Homes serve abused, abandoned, neglected & at-risk children in Tennessee through our assessment center and long-term residential program. Our goal is to provide a safe environment with trained, loving house parents & staff to help nurture hurting boys & girls—and their families—find answers & lay a solid foundation on which they can rebuild the broken pieces of their lives.



Virginia Ministries

We operate two homes in Virginia; the Victory Boys' Home in Norton opened in March 2000 & the Bristol Boys' Home opened in the spring of 2005. We strive to provide a caring home with a Christian family model. House parents offer spiritual guidance and instruction in social, independent living and daily skills, while encouraging family involvement. Our on-site case manager and house parents assure medical and counseling appointments are kept and each child is given the love and care they deserve.



Arkansas Ministries

In Dec. 2003, we were given a historical 12,500 sq. ft. facility known as the Florence Crittenton Home in Little Rock, AR. With its 12 bedrooms & 7 baths, the home currently serves 0 to 17 years of age. It is our goal to reunite each child with a family member, & share Christ through daily devotions. The young people receive their own Bible upon admission into our home and are taken to church on a regular basis.



Jackson-Tolle Learning Center

The Jackson-Tolle Learning Center is our on-campus licensed school & intensive day-treatment program serving our young people through academic assessments and individualized instructions.
